Email is the best for Stan: mwvcnews@gmail.com.** The best time to call Stan (402) 362-7686 is 9:00 a.m. – early afternoon, Monday thru Saturday. Bid by lot number with maximum amount you wish to bid for each lot. Also, please indicate if you are willing to go “one increment higher” if your high bid is taken on the floor. Your bid will be entered competitively at one bid increment over the next highest bid or 50 per cent of your maximum bid, whichever is higher. Thus, you may purchase your item for less than your maximum bid. A 5% handling charge (minimum of \$3.00 total) will be added to the selling price of winning absentee bids, plus shipping and insurance (no sales tax).
